Applicant requirements

The applicant must submit one of the following documents:

- A copy of his or her DD-214 showing receipt of the award or showing active duty during the timeframes defined.
- A copy of the award certificate with the applicant’s name identified as the recipient the specific military medal.
- Proof of active duty during the timeframes defined by providing a Military ID card (cards issued after April 1, 2005 do not indicate status) or a letter from a commanding officer.

Any of the timeframes listed below indicate the service member is eligible for the National Defense plates:

- Korean War – 1950-1954
- Vietnam War – 1971-1974
- Persian Gulf War – 1990-1995
- War on Terrorism – 2001-Present

Service members who were a member of the inactive reserve do not qualify for the National Defense plates.
