

## Purple Heart Disability

<b>Link in BASS:</b>	PURPLE HEART DISABLD
<b>Eligible vehicle classes:</b>	PC, NC, NT, HV, MH, UN, MC
<b>Eligible reserve types:</b>	System-assigned stock plate number Personalized (no more than six characters) Initial
<b>Cost:</b>	There are no fees, including postage, taxes, and state fees, for a system assigned stock plate number. Additional annual fees for a personalized or initial plate are discounted by 25%.

### Applicant requirements

**New Issuance** - The applicant must submit all of the following:

- A completed BMV 4507, *Registration Application for Gratis Military License Plates* form (submitted over the counter)
- A copy of his or her DD-214 showing Purple Heart, or copy of award certificate
- A letter, dated within the last year, from the Department of Veteran Affairs stating owner has a 100% service-connected disability rating or has received a monetary allowance toward the purchase of a motor vehicle.

**Renewal (personalized or initial only)** – When renewing the plate, the applicant must submit a letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs, dated within the past year, indicating the appropriate qualification. The DD-214 does not need to be presented at renewal.

### **Additional Information**

- Purple Heart Disability plates:
  - Do not expire (12/31/2050) unless personalized or initial.
  - Do not qualify for plate number retention.
  - Cannot be transferred to a spouse.
- The number of Purple Heart Disability plates permitted is limited to the number of vehicles titled and registered in the qualifying applicant's name.
- When issuing in BASS, select "SSN" type on the *Vehicle Registration* page. "Disability" does not need selected for the plate option to be available.
